




- (i) Steel Rajesh has a steel bottle.



1. Take the ages of your family members and draw the Bar graph with a proper scale.




- 2. Make your table chart from 1 to 100 to differentiate prime numbers and composite numbers with color code.


- (3) Draw/Stick a physical map of India from a map book and locate
